

Alignment with the UN Sustainable Development Goals

The high significance of sustainability for the management of EVN is also illustrated by the efforts to evaluate current CSR developments with regard to their importance for the company as quickly as possible. EVN's areas of activity were therefore analysed in 2015/16 from the viewpoint of the UN's 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which took effect on 1 January 2016. The analysis also identified the elements in EVN's CSR programme that are already making a specific contribution to attaining these goals.
